The Plot :

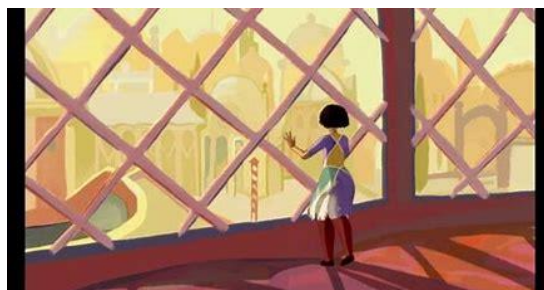
The spectators enter a picture whose characters are alive.
